Non-Rated Sections: Notation is not required, no clocks will be used

No Score / Open to Pre-K to Kindergarten students who are absolute beginners. Many of the participants may not know all the rules of chess. There will be constant supervision of this section. Trophies to all.

Novice 1 / Open to grades 1-2 who are not USCF members. Kindergarten students may also play if their parents wish. While notation is encouraged it is not required. No clocks will be used. Trophies to Top 10, then medals to all.

Novice 2 / Open to grades 3-12 who are not USCF members. While notation is encouraged, it is not required. No clocks will be used. Trophies to Top 10, then medals to all.

Kids Help Kids / Section for children who are blind, deaf, or have some other kind of disability. **(New Section!** Sponsored by CAREChessClub).

Rated Sections: Notation is required, please bring your own clock

K-1: 4 Rounds, Game/45. Open to Kindergarten and 1st Grade, USCF Rating below 600. Trophies to Top 10, then medals to all.

Primary: 4 Rounds, Game/45. Open to K-3. USCF Rating below 900. Trophies to Top 10, then medals to all.

Reserve: 4 Rounds, Game/45. Open to K-12, USCF Rating below 1000. Trophies to Top 10, then medals to all.

Classic: 4 Rounds, Game/60. Open to K-12, USCF Rating between 1000 and 1299. Trophies to Top 10, then medals to all.

Open Section: 4 Rounds, Game/60. Open to K-12, USCF Rating 1300-1599. Trophies to Top 10, then medals to all.

Championship Section: 3 Rounds, Game/75. Open to K-12, USCF Rating 1600+. Prizes to Top 10. Prizes will include popular electronics, elegant wooden chess sets, chess clocks, video game consoles, and books, among other things! Details about prizes will be posted at www.ijlef/carechessclub.org. Free Entry to kids rated over 2000.
