President Trump's Immigration Action Plan. How does it impact you?

KNOW YOUR RIGHTS IF ICE STOPS IN YOU PUBLIC. HOME OR WORK.

DACA recipients who may or may not be eligible for other forms of relief **NEED TO MEET WITH AN ATTORNEY** to reassess their immigration status. Individuals who may not have been eligible for alternate forms of relief when initially granted DACA may now be eligible due to changed circumstances (such as travel on advanced parole). For this reason, DACA beneficiaries are strongly encouraged to assess whether other forms of relief are now available, through consultations with an attorney, even if the DACA recipient was screened when he or she initially applied for DACA.

Enter the Official DV-2019 USA Green Card Lottery

The annual Diversity Visa Lottery also known as the "Green Card Lottery" is a United States government program that makes approximately 55,000 Permanent Resident cards available every year to persons from "under represented countries," which have been less represented in employment and family-based preference categories in the United States of America and who meet two basic eligibility requirements. This year's (2017) Green Card Lottery Program is called DV-2019 (the year successful applicants may enter the United States of America on the Green Card they won), and is now open to all individuals worldwide who meet two basic entry requirements. The program makes Lawful Permanent Resident Cards available to the winners, authorizing the winners and their families to live, study and work in the United States of America as permanent residents. The official website is www.dvlottery.state.gov. You may submit the E-DV Entry Form or DS-5501, electronically online. Processing begins 12:00 noon, Tuesday, October 3rd, 2017 to 12:00 noon, November 7th, 2017. Don't wait until the last week! In the Caribbean, unfortunately, the Dominican Republic, Jamaica and Haiti, are ineligible.
